Khadi & Apparels Fashion Show Steals the Spotlight


















Khadi Shines at UPITS 2024: A Fashion Extravaganza

Models graced the runway, wearing beautifully designed Khadi apparel, captivating the audience with its unique blend of tradition and contemporary style.

The fashion show was graced by Shri Giriraj Singh, Hon'ble Union Minister of Textiles, who commended the efforts of the government in reviving and promoting Khadi as a global fabric. In his address, Shri Singh highlighted the role of Khadi in Prime Minister Modi's 5 Fs vision (Farm to Fiber to Fabric to Fashion to Foreign), underlining its importance in boosting the textile industry and creating jobs. He also praised the ongoing initiatives like PM Mitra Parks in Lucknow and Unnao, which are driving growth in the textile sector, especially in Uttar Pradesh.

Knowledge Sessions



A key knowledge session titled "Navigating the Global Marketplace: Potential Challenges and Strategies for Indian Exporters" was held, bringing together policymakers and industry experts to discuss the future of Indian exports in a rapidly changing global trade environment. The session was attended by notable figures including Shri Rakesh Sachan, Cabinet Minister for MSME, Khadi, Village Industries, Sericulture, Textile, Government of Uttar Pradesh; Shri Nand Gopal Gupta 'Nandi', Cabinet Minister for Industrial Development, Export Promotion, NRI, Investment Promotion, Government of Uttar Pradesh; Shri Alok Kumar, IAS, Principal Secretary, Departments of Sports, Youth Affairs, MSME, Khadi & Village Industries, Handloom & Textile in Government. of Uttar Pradesh; Shri Pranjal Yadav, IAS, Secretary, MSME and Export Promotion, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh; Ajay Sahai, DG & CEO, FIEO; Vivek Aggarwal, Partner & Lead, KPMG; Shri Amit Kumar, Head-North Region, ECGC Ltd.; and Ajay Srivastava, Founder of the Global Trade Research Initiative.

Shri Rakesh Sachan, Cabinet Minister for MSME, Khadi, Village Industries, Sericulture, Textile, Government of Uttar Pradesh ensures the state government's full support to exporters and businesses. He emphasized that Uttar Pradesh is committed to providing all possible assistance to help local industries thrive in the global marketplace. Sachan underlined that boosting exports is crucial to realizing the dream of making Uttar Pradesh a trillion-dollar economy, adding that without significant strides in exports, achieving such an ambitious target would be nearly impossible. Shri Nand Gopal Gupta 'Nandi', Cabinet Minister for Industrial Development, Export Promotion, NRI, Investment Promotion, Government of Uttar Pradesh underscored Uttar Pradesh's advantages in terms of manpower, consumer base, and infrastructure. He also shared that several exhibitors at UPITS 2024 have already secured export orders up to 2027, reflecting the state's increasing prominence as a global trade player.

Ajay Sahai, Director General & CEO of FIEO, provided an insightful overview of the current export trends during the session. He acknowledged the significant progress India has made in the global market but emphasized that there is still a long way to go. Sahai shared encouraging data reflecting the upward trajectory of Indian exports, particularly from Uttar Pradesh, highlighting sectors that have shown strong growth in recent years.

Reflecting on Uttar Pradesh's role in the export ecosystem, Shri Alok Kumar emphasized the state's potential to drive India's economy towards the one trillion-dollar goal through exports. He noted that Uttar Pradesh, with its vast population and growing industrial capabilities, is positioned to play a significant role in global trade. He also highlighted the efforts being made by the Uttar Pradesh government to attract foreign investment and facilitate exports, particularly in sectors like electronics, which have seen rapid growth.

In closing, the panellists highlighted the need for continuous adaptation to global market demands and urged businesses to leverage government schemes and infrastructure development initiatives to enhance their export potential.



Session on Financing for 1 Trillion \$ Economy

A knowledge session on "Financing for a \$1 Trillion Economy" was held, featuring Shri Suresh Kumar Khanna, Hon'ble Minister of Finance and Parliamentary Affairs, Uttar Pradesh; Smt. Ministhy S, Secretary, Finance & DG, Institutional Finance, UP; Shri Rikesh Chand, CGM, Exim Bank; and Shri Sameer, Special Secretary, Finance, UP.

Shri Suresh Kumar Khanna, Hon'ble Minister of Finance and Parliamentary Affairs, Uttar Pradesh emphasized the state's commitment to achieving a trillion-dollar economy through robust financial systems, strategic investments, and public-private partnerships. He highlighted the importance of financial inclusion and sustainable fiscal policies in driving growth.

Smt. Ministhy S, Secretary, Finance & DG, Institutional Finance, UP discussed institutional finance, focusing on **credit accessibility** for MSMEs and the role of the **SLBC** in financial inclusion. She advocated for **innovative financing models** to support business expansion.

The session concluded with a shared commitment to building a strong financial ecosystem for economic growth.

Another session on 'Insurance Awareness and the Importance of Insurance for the People of Uttar Pradesh' by IRDAI provided valuable insights into the critical role insurance plays in securing financial stability and safeguarding livelihoods. Experts emphasized the need for widespread awareness, particularly in rural areas, where many remain unaware of the benefits and accessibility of insurance products. The discussion highlighted how insurance can act as a safety net, protecting families and businesses from unforeseen events, and explored various government schemes aimed at increasing coverage.
