UPITS 2024 Concludes with Resounding Success

The entire hemp plant has multiple uses—hemp seeds, for instance, are rich in nutrition, providing around 30-35 grams of protein per 100 grams, even surpassing fish oil. The fabric made from hemp is naturally antifungal, antibacterial, and thermal-resistant, making it incredibly versatile. Hemp is also one of the strongest fibers in the world and is a negative-emission plant, meaning it absorbs more carbon dioxide than it emits, which makes it a crucial component in the fight against climate change. Overall, UPITS 2024 has been a significant milestone for us in our mission to promote sustainable, eco-friendly solutions.
