Enabling the Startup Ecosystem in Uttar Pradesh to Achieve the \$1 Trillion Economy Vision



The inaugural day of UPITS 2025 featured a thought-provoking panel on strengthening Uttar Pradesh's startup ecosystem to fuel its \$1 trillion economy vision. Moderated by Vandana Sharma, Innovation Hub-UP, AKTU, the session brought together leading academic and institutional voices. Prof. Deepu Philip, IIT Kanpur emphasized the transition from generic pharma to IP-driven drug discovery, citing CurEta Therapeutics as a success, while highlighting also advances in semiconductors and DSP for 5G/6G. Prof. Manoj

Kumar Meshram, IIT BHU spotlighted grassroots innovation, with over 100 startups—including Physics Wallah-and sustainable farming models led by SHGs and women entrepreneurs. Prof. Yamini Bhusan Pandey, IIM Lucknow-Noida underlined role of R&D the commercialization, referencing success stories like Ather Energy and fintech ventures valued up to ₹2,500 crore. Dr. Rahul Amritraj, GIMS Greater Noida introduced healthcare incubation, with breakthroughs such as Matri, a non-invasive solution for menstrual pain, and innovations in CT scans and anesthesia devices. Mahip Singh, Innovation Hub-UP, **AKTU** detailed its initiative to build 300 incubation centres. including an AI app for accident damage assessment and repair connectivity. The session underscored that Uttar Pradesh's blend of world-class institutions, grassroots innovation, and robust incubation networks is shaping the state into a powerhouse of technology, enterprise, and scalable innovation.

Key focus areas included chip design NCR, in development through Centres of Excellence, internships and well training, as indigenisation of defence and security technologies. With strong policy support, innovation-driven product creation, and skilling initiatives, Uttar Pradesh is emerging as a growth engine for India's global electronics leadership.


economy and global leadership in sustainable growth.








A Cultural Tapestry: The UPITS 2025 Evening Spectacle
