Greater Noida, September 25, 2025: Uttar Pradesh steps into the global spotlight today as the third edition of the Uttar **Pradesh International Trade** Show (UPITS 2025) opens at the India Expo Centre & Mart, Greater Noida. The five-day extravaganza to be inaugurated by Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India in the august presence of Shri Yogi Adityanath, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh: Shri Rakesh Sachan, Hon'ble Minister of MSME, Khadi, Village Industries, Sericulture, Textile, Uttar Pradesh and Nand Gopal Gupta (Nandi), Minister of NRI and **Investment Promotion, Uttar** Pradesh. The flagship trade show is being jointly organised by the Government of Uttar Pradesh and India Exposition

Mart Ltd. The event reflects the Prime Minister's ambitious vision of transforming Uttar Pradesh into a \$1 trillion economy, as well as the leadership of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, whose dynamic policies have accelerated the state's growth trajectory.

From its very inception, UPITS was envisioned as more than just an exhibition—it was designed as a bridge between local artisans and global markets, tradition and technology, craft and commerce, and culture and cuisine. In only two editions, the show has cemented Uttar Pradesh's place on the global sourcing map, giving MSMEs, exporters, and entrepreneurs unprecedented exposure. With

its third edition, UPITS is now bigger, broader, and more inclusive than ever before, carrying forward its theme, "Ultimate Sourcing Begins Here."

This year, the trade show unfolds across a massive 1,10,000 square metres of exhibition space, featuring more than 2,400 exhibitors and welcoming an anticipated footfall of over 1,25,000 business visitors, over 500 Foreign Buyers from 85 countries and 4,50,000 consumers. The exhibition halls present a vibrant mix of sectors including Agriculture & Allied Sectors, Apparel / Textile / Handloom, Automobile/ EV / Auto Components, Chemicals, Gas & Paints, Education Skills and

Building Bridges Between Buyers & Brands

UPITS 2025 is set to welcome a diverse and global mix of buyers and visitors, building on the momentum of its first two editions. In 2023, the show attracted about 1,914 exhibitors, over 70,000 B2B visitors, and roughly 2,37,000 B2C visitors, with more than

400 international buyers participating. For 2024, the numbers rose even higher: about 2,122 exhibitors, approximately, 100,000 business-buyers and 3,50,000 B2C visitors, alongside over 450 foreign buyers from around 70

countries. With UPITS 2025, organisers are aiming even higher — expecting over **2,400** exhibitors, **125,000** B2B visitors, **450,000** B2C visitors, and more than **500** international buyers drawn from some **85 countries**.

The spirit of UPITS 2025 lies in its ability to innovate, integrate, and internationalise. Exhibitors are being encouraged to showcase innovations that align with emerging market demands, integrate with global supply chains, and internationalise their brands by connecting with buyers from across the world. For a state that already accounts for over 10% of India's exports and boasts a network of nearly

96 lakh MSMEs, UPITS has emerged as the perfect launchpad to take this momentum forward.

This edition introduces a

unique three-dimensional buyer engagement strategy, catering simultaneously to international buyers, domestic B2B buyers, and domestic B2C visitors. By doing so, UPITS ensures that opportunities are created for every participant—whether it is a large-scale exporter seeking

global buyers, a small business exploring new domestic markets, or consumers looking for authentic, high-quality products directly from the source.

The partnership with Russia adds a strong international dimension to this year's show. Dedicated spaces have been created to host Indo-Russian dialogues and B2B networking sessions, opening doors to long-term collaborations across industries such as



engineering, defence, IT, and manufacturing. This partnership is expected not only to enhance trade volumes but also to foster technological exchange and strategic alliances between the two nations.

Beyond trade, UPITS celebrates the very identity of Uttar Pradesh. The exhibition floor is alive with the spirit of the One District One Product (ODOP) initiative, where the crafts of Bhadohi, the glassware of Firozabad, the carpets of Mirzapur, the textiles of Varanasi, and the leather of Kanpur stand proudly on display. Besides, GI tagged products, Export excellence hubs, Women **Entrepreneurs,** and **Student Start-ups** are displaying their prowess at the global platform. Every pavilion narrates the story of a district, its people, and its traditions, making UPITS not just an industrial fair but a true cultural showcase of the state.
